In December 2015, the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) was signed into law. Highlights of ESSA include holding all students to high academic standards and ensuring that the lowest-performing schools are provided the appropriate supports for school improvement.

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that the State has identified your child's school as a Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school. Due to the extraordinary circumstances created by the COVID-19 pandemic, school accountability designations from the 2019-20 school year will be maintained in the 2021-2022 school year. Schools serving specialized populations are evaluated using the Alternative Performance Framework (APF). The APF provides program evaluation for schools that offer services such as credit recovery, behavioral/continuation programs, serve adjudicated youth, or provide special education services to students with multiple or severe cognitive disabilities.
